In Pt. 4 of our *Scripture Series* we get to slow down and really understand **the final moments in the Mortal Life of the Savior of the World**. This series we have entitled the *Last Week of the Saviors Life*, but a majority of the series will be centered on the final 24 hours of His life as this is where the Savior performs the Atonement on behalf of the entire human family.

The Christian world call this week; "*Holy Week*" or sometimes "*Passion Week*". It is the week where the Savior fulfilled His mission and brought about the most significant events in human history.

Of the 1,716 weeks of the Saviors Life, the events of the Last Week of His Life compromise 30% of the material in Gospel accounts; Matthew, Mark, Luke, & John. The events of the Last hours of His life is where these Gospel writers chose to spend their time and it is very easy to understand why.

One of the greatest Gospel Scholars of all-time said this about the events of that week, that they are, *"the most transcendent events that ever has or ever will occur from Creation's dawn through all the ages of a never-ending eternity."* (Bruce R. McConkie, "The Purifying Power of Gethsemane," *Ensign*, May 1985).

President Gordon B. Hinckley described the events of that week as *"the miracle that encompasses all who have lived upon the earth, all who now live upon the earth, and all who will yet live upon the earth. Nothing done before or since has so affected mankind as the Atonement wrought by Jesus of Nazareth"* (Gordon B. Hinckley, "The Greatest Miracle in Human History," *Ensign,*

May 1994, 72).

Elder Gary E. Stevenson, in his April 2023 talk quoted a New Testament scholar N. T. Wright who suggested: "We should be taking steps to celebrate Easter in creative new ways: in art, literature, children's games, poetry, music, dance, festivals, bells, special concerts. … This is our greatest festival. Take Christmas away, and in biblical terms you lose two chapters at the front of Matthew and Luke, nothing else. Take Easter away, and you don't have a New Testament; you don't have a Christianity."

We can't think of a more appropriate place to slow down and take our time than reviewing in as much detail as we can these powerful events.

It would be accurate to say that the knowledge and material we get to discuss and cover in this series fits ideally with what President Romney called, *'The most important knowledge in the Universe!'*

So...in a nutshell we will cover the Last Week of the Saviors Life including His post-resurrection ministry and will not be done until we conclude this series with the Ascension when He completes His mortal ministry there in Palestine. We might be the most excited about this part of the Series as it covers the **most** transcendent events in the history of the world.

We maintain that once you have taken a Tour (or Virtual Tour) of the Holy Land, **"You will never read the scriptures the same way again!"** And will add...you will **never worship the Savior the same way again either**. O The more we understand ourselves O the more clearly we understand life and our purpose in it. The more clear we are on our purpose in life, the happier we are and O the more meaningful and peaceful life is for us... knowing who we are...why we are here...

One of my very favorite and relevant scriptures is...

"This is life eternal, they might **know thee**, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom thou has sent." (John 17:3). I am a very simple minded man and appreciate scriptures that are straight forward like this one. Said in another scripture from a different Prophet, "...and if they **know me** they shall have a place eternally at my right hand." (Mosiah 26:24) Stated simply...if we KNOW GOD and Jesus Christ we will have Eternal Life!

In the Parable of the 10 virgins...when the unwise virgins return from obtaining oil and seek to come in to join the celebratory feast, the Bridegroom meets them at the door and denies them entrance with these piercing words, "Depart from me...Ye never knew me!" (Matt 25:12). Elder Oaks says the 10 Virgins represent members of the Church. That means that 50% will not be prepared when He comes.

In similar fashion...in Christ's most famous sermon (the Sermon on the Mount), Jesus describes a scenario where certain people on judgment day plead their case saying, 'Lord, Lord, have we not

prophesied in thy name and in thy name cast out devils, and done many wonderful works? Then will He profess under them with these same piercing words... Depart from me...Ye never knew me." (Matt 7:21-23).

Getting to know God and His Son; Jesus Christ, is THE most important relationship we can develop in this life! We simply need to KNOW HIM! One of the best ways to get to know Him is to understand His revealed words to us. In our "*Holy Land Scripture Series*" we will start with Genesis and move our way all the way through Revelation (and other revealed scripture) in an effort to understand the key doctrines, stories, & events that will help us UNDERSTAND GOD and also aide in our relationship with Him!

"Recently I asked the internet, "What day most changed the course of history?"

The responses ranged from surprising and strange to insightful and thought-provoking. Among them, the day when a prehistoric asteroid struck the Yucatán Peninsula; or when in 1440, Johannes Gutenberg finished his printing press; and, of course, the day in 1903 when the Wright brothers showed the world that man really can fly.

If the same question were asked of you, what would you say?

In my mind the answer is clear.

To find the most important day in history, we must go back to that evening almost 2,000 years ago in the Garden of Gethsemane when Jesus Christ knelt in intense prayer and offered Himself as a ransom for our sins. It was during this great and infinite sacrifice of unparalleled suffering in both body and spirit that Jesus Christ, even God, bled at every pore. Out of perfect love, He gave all that we might receive all. His supernal sacrifice, difficult to comprehend, to be felt only with all our heart and mind, reminds us of the universal debt of gratitude we owe Christ for His divine gift. Later that night, Jesus was brought before religious and political authorities who mocked Him, beat Him, and sentenced Him to a shameful death. He hung in agony upon the cross until, finally, "it [was] finished."2 His lifeless body was laid in a borrowed tomb. And then, on the morning of the third day, Jesus Christ, the Son of Almighty God, emerged from the tomb as a glorious, resurrected being of splendor, light, and majesty.

Yes, there are many events throughout history that have profoundly affected the destiny of nations and peoples. But combine them all, and they cannot begin to compare to the importance of what happened on that first Easter morning.

What is it that makes the infinite sacrifice and the Resurrection of Jesus Christ the most important event in history—more influential than world wars, cataclysmic disasters, and life-changing scientific discoveries?" "His Atonement is the most transcendent event that ever has or ever will occur from Creation's dawn through all the ages of a never-ending eternity. It is the supreme act of goodness and grace that only a god could perform. Through it, all of the terms and conditions of the Father's eternal plan of salvation became operative. Through it are brought to pass the immortality and eternal life of man—The Atonement of Christ is the most basic and fundamental doctrine of the gospel, and it is the least understood of all our revealed truths. Many of us have a superficial knowledge and rely upon the Lord and his goodness to see us through the trials and perils of life. But if we are to have faith like Enoch and Elijah we must believe what they believed, know what they knew, and live as they lived" (Bruce R. McConkie, "The Purifying Power of Gethsemane," *Ensign*, May 1985).

<u>Elder Callister</u> has written, "If a survey were taken of history's most significant events, common answers might include the harnessing of fire, the discovery of America, the splitting of the atom, landing on the moon, or the invention of the computer. Each is a wondrous event, but absent the backdrop of the Atonement each is of but transitory importance—no more than a shooting star illuminating the sky for a brief moment, and then vanishing into the night. The Atonement gives purpose and potency to every event in history" (Callister).
