2. This was a VERY bold move on the part of Elijah. What does this tell us about him?
3. What was the purpose of the duel?
4. What does it mean in scripture when you see the word **LORD** in all capital letters? (What was the word in the original text? Why did they substitute that word with LORD?)
5. Why did Elijah drench the bullock and alter with water? Why 3 times?
6. How specifically did the audience respond when the bullock and alter were consumed by fire?
7. Was there anyone attending that event who didn't know and understand that the LORD God of Abraham was the true God and not the gods of Baal?
8. How long did this conviction and conversion last?
9. It is amazing that this dramatic miracle didn't produce more committed and converted people. How would you describe the process of "*True Conversion?*"

10. If miracles and miraculous events don't produce conversion, then what does?
11. Which quote shared from our living prophets/apostles/leaders in the lecture did you find most insightful? Why?
12. What has made the biggest impact or influence in your own personal conversion?
13. What advice would you give someone about the process of conversion who is not familiar with the Church or spiritual things?
14. What does *Romans 5:19* (quoted in the lecture) have to do with the topic of personal conversion?
